



# Make your donation go further

**All donations to the Liston College Foundation Fund of \$5 or more are tax deductible in New Zealand.**

This means that you can claim a third of your donation back from the IRD at the end of the financial year.

Claiming your tax rebate and gifting it back to the Liston College Foundation Fund is an easy yet effective way to make your donation go even further.

For example, if you donate \$100, you are eligible to claim back \$33 - and by donating this back to the Liston College Foundation Fund, your gift is actually worth \$133.

## How do I claim my tax rebate?

It's now easier than ever to get back your 33.3% tax credit on your charitable giving with the Inland Revenue's [myIR](#) portal. Simply log in any time, submit photos or scans of your receipts, and you will receive your tax credit back at the end of the tax year.

Alternatively, make sure you keep hold of all your tax receipts, and complete the tax rebate form (IR526) after 31 March. The form is available to download from the IRD's [website](#).

## Donating your tax rebate to the Liston College Foundation Fund.

Auckland Foundation, the community foundation for Auckland, administers the Liston College Foundation Fund.

## Can I get a receipt for donating my rebate to the Liston College Foundation Fund?

Yes! Simply email [info@aucklandfoundation.org.nz](mailto:info@aucklandfoundation.org.nz) with confirmation of your donation, who will then send you a tax receipt to claim a further tax credit on this amount the following tax year.
